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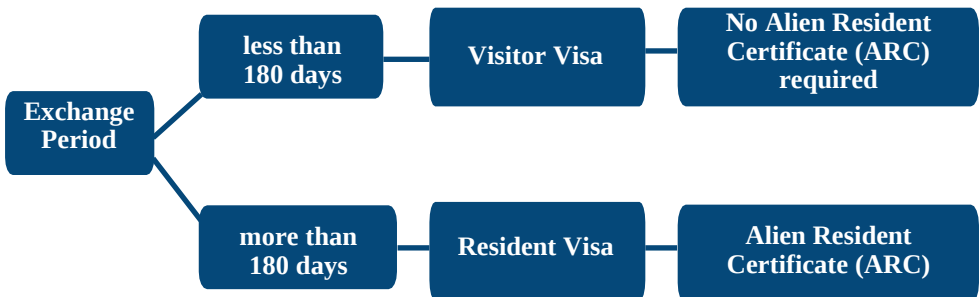


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Visa

Contact the [Taiwan diplomatic mission](#) in your country/region for the most up-to-date and accurate information regarding visa requirements. Visa regulations may vary depending on your nationality, so it is important to check the specific application process and documentation required for your location. To apply for a Visitor Visa, complete the application form for your specific country on the [Taiwan diplomatic mission website](#). Be sure to start the process well in advance, as visa processing times can vary.

For students who are Mainland Chinese nationals, please skip this chapter and refer instead to the Entry Permit guideline sheet provided separately.



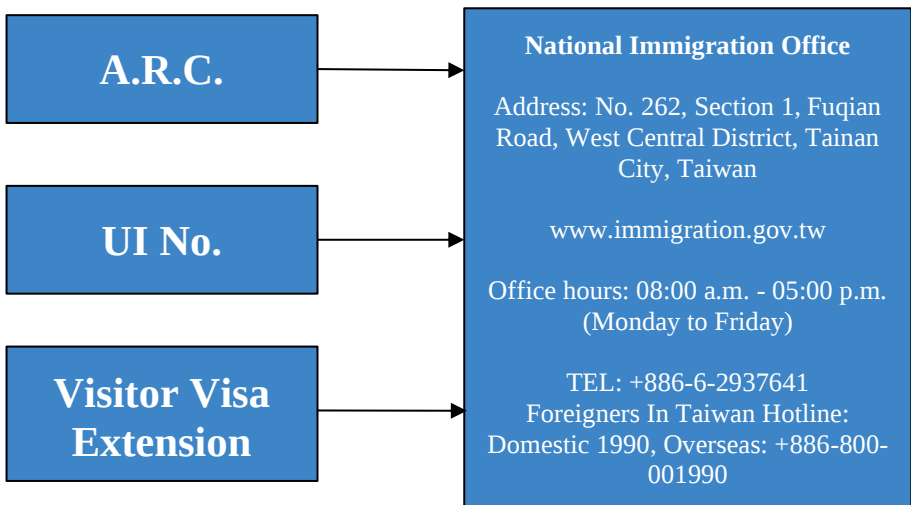
Apply for ARC within 30 days
(starting from next day of arrival)

Visitor Visa

1. All students coming to NCKU for an exchange program must apply for a Visitor or Resident Visa through a Taiwan diplomatic mission.
2. Please check with the Taiwan diplomatic mission or visit the [Bureau of Consular Affairs website](#) for detailed visa information.
3. If the duration of stay on your visa does not cover your full exchange or visiting period, you will need to apply for a Visitor Visa Extension. Please note that overstaying your visa can result in fines. For extension details, consult the [National Immigration Agency](#).

To apply for a Visitor Visa, you will need to prepare the following documents:

- A valid passport (must be valid for the entire duration of your exchange)
- Completed visa application form
- NCKU hardcopy acceptance letter (*please contact the outbound coordinator at your home university to collect it)
- Proof of sufficient financial means
- Any additional documents requested by the consular office

“Do not enter Taiwan using a landing visa or through the visa waiver program, as these may cause complications with immigration procedures when you leave or re-enter the country.”

Airports may be the most convenient location to exchange foreign currencies into New Taiwan Dollars, as most banks only accept limited types of foreign currencies, which may include US dollars, Euro, Japanese Yen, Chinese Yuan, and HK dollars. Please check with the bank before heading over. Additionally, it’s possible to withdraw money from ATMs at Convenience Stores for a transaction fee.

🚫 Opening a Bank Account

Bring your passport and Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) to a local bank and fill out all necessary forms; you can ask the bank teller for help. Typically, to open a bank account, you have to deposit at least NTD 1,000. We strongly advise that you apply for a bank card, so you'll be able to withdraw money from ATMs at any time.

1. An ARC is required for all foreign students wishing to open a local bank account or post office account in Taiwan. **This is a new policy entered into effect on 13 June 2025 for Taiwan Post Office.*
2. Foreign students whose stay is less than six months are **not** eligible to apply for an ARC, and therefore **cannot** open a bank or post office account during their time in Taiwan.
3. If you are not considered a legal adult under the law in Taiwan, you will need a letter of consent from your guardian in Taiwan or from an embassy-approved overseas legal guardian. It is often easier to solicit parental or legal consent before you arrive.

🚫 Using Credit Cards/Bank Cards

Before coming to Taiwan, consult the bank in your home country to see whether you can use your credit cards/bank cards to withdraw money in Taiwan and the transaction fees that apply.





Accommodation

On-Campus Dorm

For students wishing to stay in on-campus housing, there are three dormitories available:

- Ching-Yeh 3 (敬業三舍)
- Sheng-Li 6 (勝利六舍)
- Dong-Ning Dormitory (東寧宿舍) – offering 3 different room types

These dorms are designated for graduate and exchange students. You can find room photos and fee information [here](#).

To apply, log in to the [application portal](#) during the designated period and rank all the dorm options in your order of preference. For the application schedule and details, please refer to the [Housing Service Division's announcements](#).

Application period: **10 am, July 01 - 10 am, July 30 (GMT+8)**

**Weekend check-outs require prior approval by the dorm manager and are subject to extra charges. This policy differs from dorm to dorm. Consult your dorm manager for details before you book your return flight back home.*

Remarks and Notes

1. Roommates will be randomly assigned.
2. NCKU cannot provide student housing for couples or families.
3. For fire safety reasons, all NCKU dormitories are equipped only with a small kitchenette.
 - The kitchenette allows the use of rice cookers only.
 - Stoves, ovens, and any other electrical cooking appliances are not provided and strictly prohibited.
 - Please keep this in mind when planning your meals during your stay.
4. You can pay the rent [online](#), or at the machines on the ground floor of the dormitory or [around campus](#) by selecting “Housing Division”.
5. The rent is charged once per semester, and once more for the in-between-semester stay, if needed.
6. If you have a local bank account, it’s also possible to pay through ATM transferring.

Check-in Procedure

1. Pay the rent through the [online system](#) or in person at one of the NCKU machines under “Housing Division”.
2. Take the receipt and bring it to your Dormitory Office upon your arrival.
3. The Dormitory Office will require you to fill out different forms related to your basic information, air conditioning and general well-keeping of the rooms.
4. Once everything is filled out, you’ll get your room key and you’ll be able to enter your room.

Dormitory Policies

Below are some of the important dormitory policies. If there are any updated dorm regulations, please abide by the new regulations.

01. Visitors

All visitors are obliged to register at the front desk. They must claim a badge and wait for the resident to be accompanied to the lobby. Visitors without registration are not permitted to enter or use the electronic key.

02. Visiting Time

The visiting time for visitors is 08:00-24:00. Visitors are obliged to leave before 24:00. Visitors who stay overnight will not be tolerated. The resident will be reported to the counselor, and further action will be taken.

03. Smoking

All residents should be aware that the dorms are non-smoking areas. Smoking is therefore prohibited.

04. Rent

Residents are required to pay rent per Semester no later than the given deadline.

05. Room Change Procedures

Residents can file one application each semester to change rooms. Please visit the [dormitory's website](#) for more detailed information..

06. Laundry Room

Residents should remove their personal belongings immediately after using the washing machine or dryer. This is highly recommended, as we often see residents missing their belongings. The Dorms do not provide detergent, so residents are recommended to bring their own and not use others. Residents should also prepare their laundry baskets and must not take someone else's. The staff will recycle items that are not retrieved for a week.

07. Clothes Hanging

Residents can hang their clothes on their balconies. The dorm does not provide hangers or other tools.

08. Drinking water machine

All residents should maintain the water machine after use.

09. Bicycle parking

The Dorms provide parking areas on the basement floors of all buildings as well as in front of the building for Bicycles. Bicycles parked outside the specified areas will be detained.

10. Security and Lock

All Dorms: The main doors are secured with an electronic lock. Residents should be reminded to use the electronic key, the resident's Student ID, and close the door shut afterward.

11. Fire Regulations

Corridors and other public areas are not for personal use. According to the fire regulations, residents are not allowed to place any personal belongings in those areas in case of fire.

12. Quiet hours

All residents should keep their voices low after 22:00 both in public areas and in their rooms, to avoid disturbing neighbors.

13. Showering

When showering, please remember to close the shower door or open the window for ventilation, to avoid triggering the smoke detector and causing the fire alarm to sound.



Off-Campus Accommodation

The following are some of the off-campus accommodation places that might be helpful to you. Please note that the University is not responsible for finding off-campus housing for students. We encourage you to be assisted by a local friend able to communicate in Chinese while searching for accommodation outside the NCKU campus.

To keep in mind...

The closer an apartment or room is to campus the higher the rent might be. So be careful when renting off-campus and check the contracts thoroughly.

Students seeking off-campus accommodations may consult independent housing options located near the university campus. These third-party resources are not affiliated with NCKU, and as such, the University is unable to provide direct consultation services, administrative support, or legal assistance related to external housing arrangements.



Course

NCKU, located in the historic city of Tainan, is widely recognized for its academic excellence and leadership in research across a broad spectrum of disciplines. Consistently ranked among the top universities in Taiwan and Asia, NCKU offers a dynamic and internationalized learning environment, fostering innovation and interdisciplinary collaboration.

Review the [NCKU Academic Calendar](#) for your exchange semester.

Exchange students can take courses offered by departments/institutes outside of their majors. Course information and schedule can be found on the [NCKU Course Information System](#). To search for a course, you need to first select the academic year. Note: 114-2 refers to Spring 2026 (the second semester of AY 2025/2026 from February 2026 to June 2026), and 115-1 means Fall 2026 (the first semester of AY 2026/2027 from September 2026 to January 2027).

If courses are taught in Chinese, consult the instructors before enrolling. Course information for the new semester will be announced roughly 1.5 months before the start of the semester. Until then, refer to the previous semesters' schedules via [Non-Current Course Catalog](#) or consult [your department offices](#) directly for assistance.





Campus Linker

One of EECS's student will be assigned to you. They will be available for any question regarding your stay at NCKU. They can assist you in answering issues concerning course enrollment and general information.

For system operation, you may also consult your Campus Linker or refer to the Instruction to Course Selection for detailed information.

Validate Your NCKU Student Account

Before the course selection, please access the [Campus website](#) to fill in all personal information required. This system closes once the semester starts, so remember to **finish this before the start of the semester**.

Once you complete filling in your personal information, finish the account validation process by changing the password to your NCKU account. This is done at the [Cheng-Kung Portal](#). For this Portal, the username is the Student’s NCKU email address, which is composed of “Student ID” and “@[ncku.edu.tw](#)”. The Student ID will be given to you via Email sent by EECS office.

Chinese class for international students (CIDS)

Chinese for International Exchange students (CIDS Courses) are General Education Courses offered by the Office of International Affairs (OIA) and conducted by the Chinese Language Center (CLC) at NCKU. These courses are designed to help international students improve their Chinese language skills for more effective communication in both academic and daily life. For more information, check out the [CLC website](#). For exchange students, the 2 hours per week CIDS courses are free-of-charge.

If you are a regular exchange student applying for CIDS Courses, please complete your application via the [CLC application website](#). *If you are a Taiwan-Europe Connectivity Scholarship recipient, please use the registration link provided separately in the scholarship approval notice sent by NCKU OIA to register for the CIDS Course (registration deadline is different from regular registration).* For any types of CIDS registration, your registration is only considered successful upon receiving the confirmation notice. If you do not receive any confirmation notice, please contact the [CLC Office](#).

General Rules for Classes

- Overlapping classes are not allowed. The course enrollment system will automatically block any schedule conflicts.
- For courses with prerequisites or outside your department, please contact the instructor by email or in person before attempting to enroll.
- Depending on the department you are enrolled in, you are required to take at least one or two courses from your department. Please read more about your specific [departmental requirements](#).
- Attendance is mandatory for most classes and is often included as part of the final grade.
- Grading components may include: midterm(s), a final exam, a final project, quizzes, (weekly) homework, and presentations.
- **If you encounter any issues during a course, you are encouraged to speak directly with the instructor or contact the corresponding [department office](#) for support.**

Restrictions and Conditions on Course Selection

1. In general, exchange students are allowed to enroll in most courses available at NCKU, including courses from other departments, except for the restricted courses.
2. Please contact the [department's coordinator](#) for particular restrictions and requirements, and ask them for the specified information.
3. Most Departments display restrictions for courses in the [course enrollment system](#).
4. All “Coursera” and “Exploring Tainan” Courses are **not** available for exchange students.

Course Information for the Upcoming Semester

1. You may find the course information on the NCKU Online Course Information in the [Course Enrollment System](#). For more details regarding the courses you are interested in, please consult the department coordinators at NCKU or the course instructors before selecting the course.
2. Please note that your student account might not be available yet during this period, so you cannot log in to plan your course schedule yet.
3. The whole process is thoroughly explained in the [Notice of Course Enrollment](#).

1st Course Enrollment Stage (July 13 - July 17)

The 1st Course Enrollment Stage is set to prioritize students who belong to that department. Thus, it is highly recommended that you sign up for all the courses **of your department** during the 1st Course Enrollment Stage.

Please note that a large number of students will log in to the system simultaneously when the Course Enrollment Stage starts. To avoid congestion when accessing the Course Enrollment System, it is highly recommended to plan your course list beforehand (by clicking “Preliminary Course Schedule”)





2nd Course Enrollment Stage

Log in to the Online Selection System to check your course results after the 1st Course Enrollment Stage ends.

At this point, you may check if certain courses still have openings (including courses from other departments) by looking up the course in the Enrollment System. If the course is already full or unavailable, you will not be able to add it to your list at this stage.

3rd Course Enrollment Stage (September 4 - September 5 & September 7 - September 8)

This Stage is divided into two phases.

During the first phase, students may check their Course Enrollment status and make adjustments by adding or dropping courses through the system.

Afterwards, an additional phase will be available during which students may continue to add courses through getting the instructor's approval or to withdraw from classes, both to be done through the system.



Former Student Says...

“Since the stages are divided into different year groups - senior, junior, sophomore, freshmen - you'll need to identify the group that corresponds to your current year and register for courses during the time slot assigned to that group.”



Health Exam and Insurance

To meet the requirements of both NCKU and the Taiwan government, all new exchange students must complete a health examination **before arriving in Taiwan**. The exam must be conducted by a qualified doctor in your home country, and the following forms must be completed:

- NCKU Exchange Health Exam Form ([Appendix 3](#)) – Required for all students
- One of the following two official health certificates, depending on your length of stay:
 - [“Medical Examination Requirements for Students Applying for Short-Term Study in Taiwan”](#) – For students staying less than 6 months
 - [“Health Certificate for Residence Application”](#) – For students staying more than 6 months

Please complete these forms in your home country and bring the original documents with you. You must submit them to the EECS office ([Please refer to the appendix for the location](#)) and the NCKU Health Center for registration.

Complete the Exam in Your Home Country

The Government Health Exam Forms and [Appendix 3](#) should be completed by the on-site exchange students no more than 3 months ahead of the registration day.

As you will need to apply for a visa at the nearest embassy in your home country, we recommend that you complete the health requirements for the visa at the same time as those required by NCKU. This approach is intended to streamline the process and help you avoid undergoing examinations twice.

Health Certificate for Residence Application

If you are a one-year exchange student and need to apply for the Resident Visa, you may need to conduct another health exam different from the NCKU Health Exam Appendix. To save time, you are advised to bring both the “**NCKU Exchange Health Exam Form**” ([Appendix 3](#)) and the “**Health Certificate for Residence Application**” to the hospital and complete them at once.

2. If you are going to do the health exam in Taiwan, please refer to the list of hospitals designated by the [Ministry of Health and Welfare](#).

Insurance ***Very important**

All incoming exchange students **MUST** obtain personal medical and accident insurance **in their home country before traveling to Taiwan**. The insurance **MUST** be valid from the date of your arrival in Taiwan until the end of your final month at NCKU.

You **MUST** provide **official proof of valid insurance coverage** (policy in English or Chinese) on the day of registration on campus.

 Important: Without presenting a valid insurance coverage proof upon arrival, you will **NOT** be permitted to begin the physical registration/enrollment process at NCKU.

Student Group Insurance (SGI)

Student Group Insurance is **required for every NCKU student**. It will be paid during the Registration period since it’s part of the enrollment process each semester. The fee will be NT\$250 per semester and covers the following medical emergencies:

Insurance Coverage	Fee
Death (caused by accident or disease)	1,000,000 NT\$
Surgery	6,000 NT\$ (maximum for each general case)
Bone Fracture	6,000 NT\$ (maximum for each case)
Hospitalization	500 NT\$ (maximum for each day less than 60 days)
Accident or Serious Injury	5,000 NT\$ (maximum for each case)

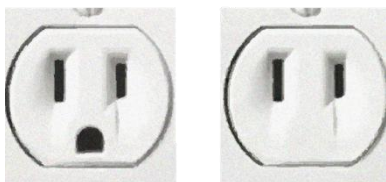
Survival Tips

Time Zone

Taiwan is located at GMT+08. All times posted in announcements from NCKU are based on Taiwan's time zone, unless otherwise noted.

AC power plugs and sockets

The Taiwanese AC power standard is 110V, and the types of sockets are as shown in the following picture. If the plugs of your electrical appliances are not the same, please bring your own voltage converter.



Climate in Tainan

Temperature in summer ranges from 27°C to 35°C. The temperature in winter ranges from 15°C to 20°C. Besides, sunny days are common in Tainan, especially from November to April. Also, there is a typhoon season in Taiwan. The typhoon season starts in June and ends in November. If you plan to travel during this period, you have to be prepared.

Earthquakes, debris flows, typhoons

Earthquakes, debris flows, and typhoons are some of the natural phenomena that might occur in Taiwan. Check the news regularly for warnings issued by the government and learn how to stay safe in advance.

Useful Services

Purchase a Prepaid SIM Card..

...at the airport

There are kiosks located inside the terminals. The cards are exclusively for tourists and at a slightly lower price than in the city, including more data and access to many public WiFi hotspots throughout the city. The only identification required for these is your passport.

- A. At Taoyuan International Airport (TPE): kiosks are located in both arrival and departure levels.
- B. At Taipei Songshan Airport (TSA): kiosks are located in terminal 1 at international arrivals.

...in the city

You can go to any of the provider stores in the city to purchase a prepaid SIM card for the regular price, but for longer periods. Most stores may require you to show a secondary piece of identification (e.g., a driver's license) and to sign forms. Please note that store employees in the city may be less likely to speak English than those at the airport, so bring a local friend with you.

EasyCard

The easiest way to pay for public transport, rent a bike, or even pay in convenience stores is by using an EasyCard.

Since you will receive your student ID card once you go through all the welcome activities, and your student ID card is an EasyCard, you don't need to purchase an EasyCard at the airports or TRA Stations.

Public Transportation



YouBike

The YouBike system is a convenient public bike-sharing service available throughout Tainan and other cities in Taiwan. YouBike stations can be found near major landmarks, parks, and schools, making it easy to get around the city. Students can register their Student ID or other EasyCards online and use it to rent and return their bikes at any station. To use the service, simply scan your card at a YouBike dock and start riding. You can add value to your card at convenience stores (e.g. 7-Eleven)



Buses

Buses in downtown Tainan can bring you to more places than a bike would. Bus stations can be found around campus as well as next to [Tainan Train Station](#).

Long Distance Transportation

Disruptive Behavior, Alcohol, and Drugs

Under no circumstances will alcohol intoxication, possession and/or use of drugs, stealing, spitting, and any other disruptive behavior be tolerated.

Smoking

1. Legal Smoking Age in Taiwan: 20 years old.
2. Smoking is prohibited on the entire National Cheng Kung University campus

Drug

According to the law, it is prohibited for any person to import, manufacture, transport, distribute, use, or possess narcotics, including but not limited to opium, marijuana, cocaine, amphetamine, pentazocine, and methadone. Any person who violates the above rule may be subject to capital punishment or life imprisonment.

Alcohol

1. Legal Drinking Age in Taiwan: 18 years old.
2. According to the law, a blood alcohol concentration (BAC) of 0.15mg/l in the breath of a driver (or 0.03% in the blood) is illegal.

Sexual Harassment

There is zero tolerance for sexual harassment in Taiwan.

Gender Equity Education Act (性別平等教育法) states the purposes of the act: “to promote substantive gender equality, eliminate gender discrimination, uphold human dignity, and improve and establish education resources and environment of gender equality.”

1. When handling sexual harassment related cases, the school shall report according to relevant laws and turn the case over to its gender equity education committee.
2. Identities of all involved parties shall be kept confidential.
3. The victim shall be informed of rights and provided with protection.



Preparation

To-do List ***Very important**

To prepare your exchange Semester at NCKU, please complete all the mentioned points. Some of the required steps are similar to those for the application of a Visitor / Student Visa, so it would be wise to prepare them at the same time:

- Apply for a [Visa](#) (Visitor / Resident)

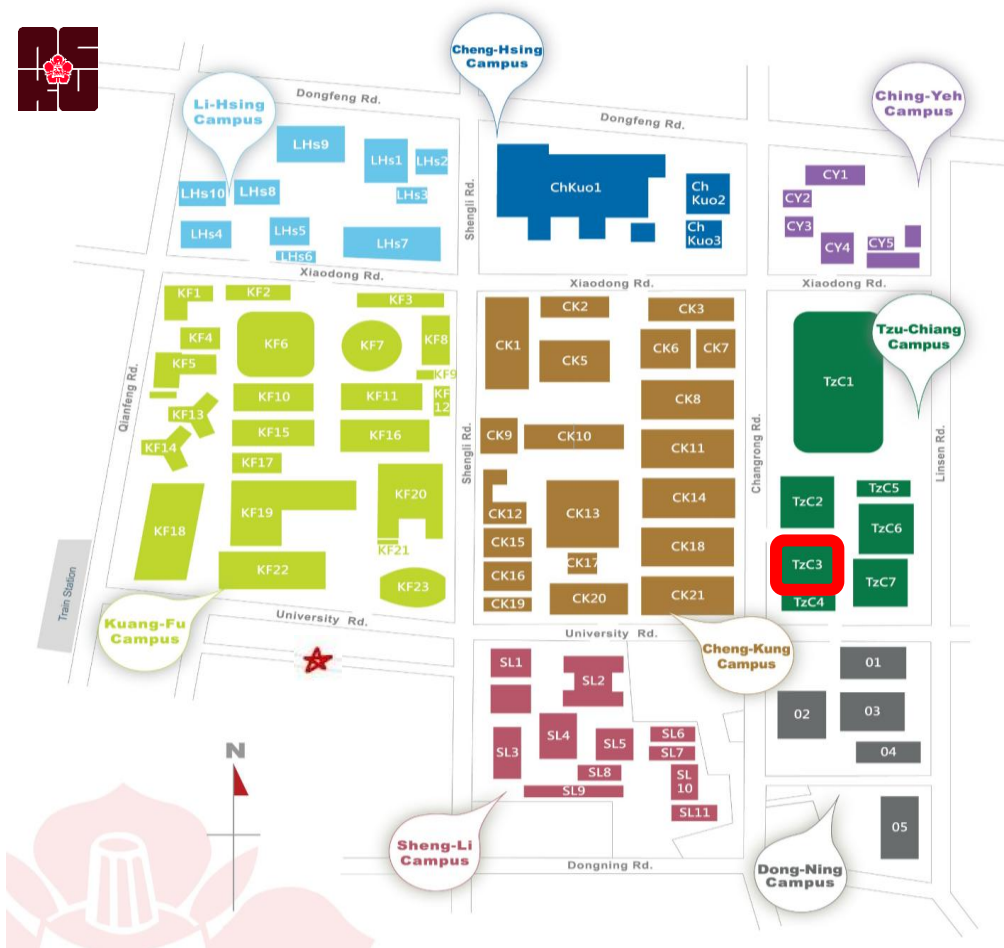

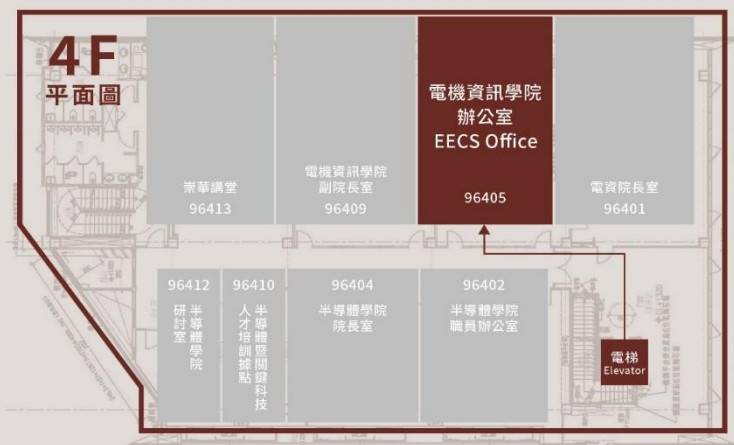


Location of EECS Office

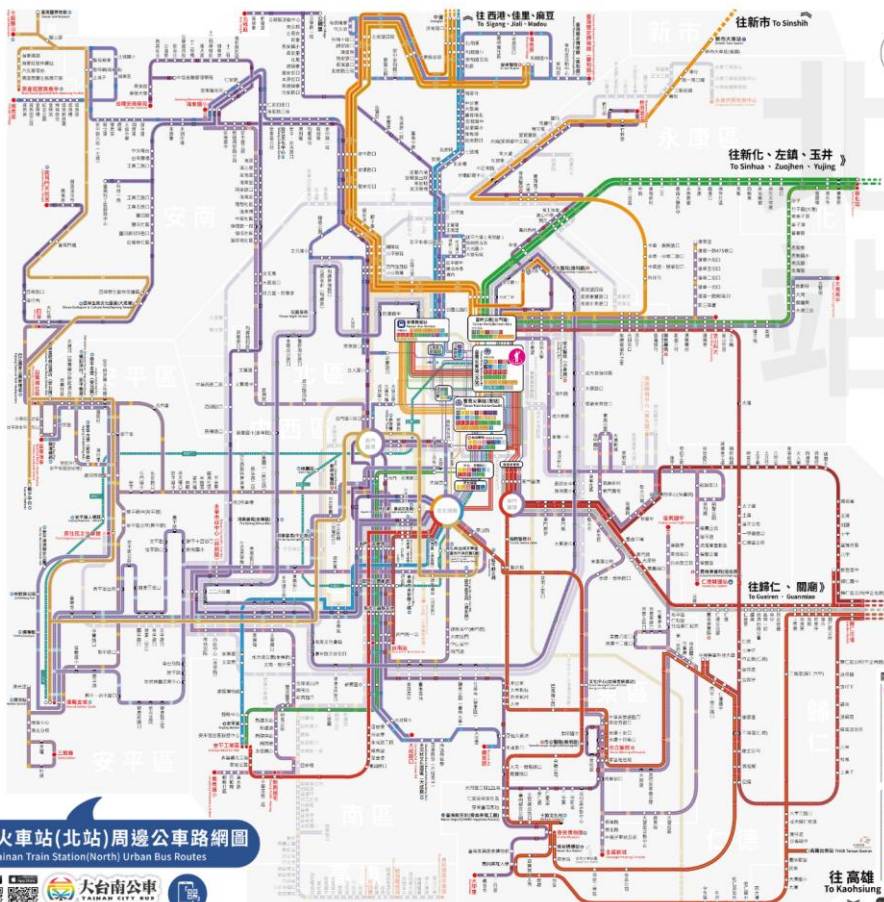

Tainan Bus Route Map



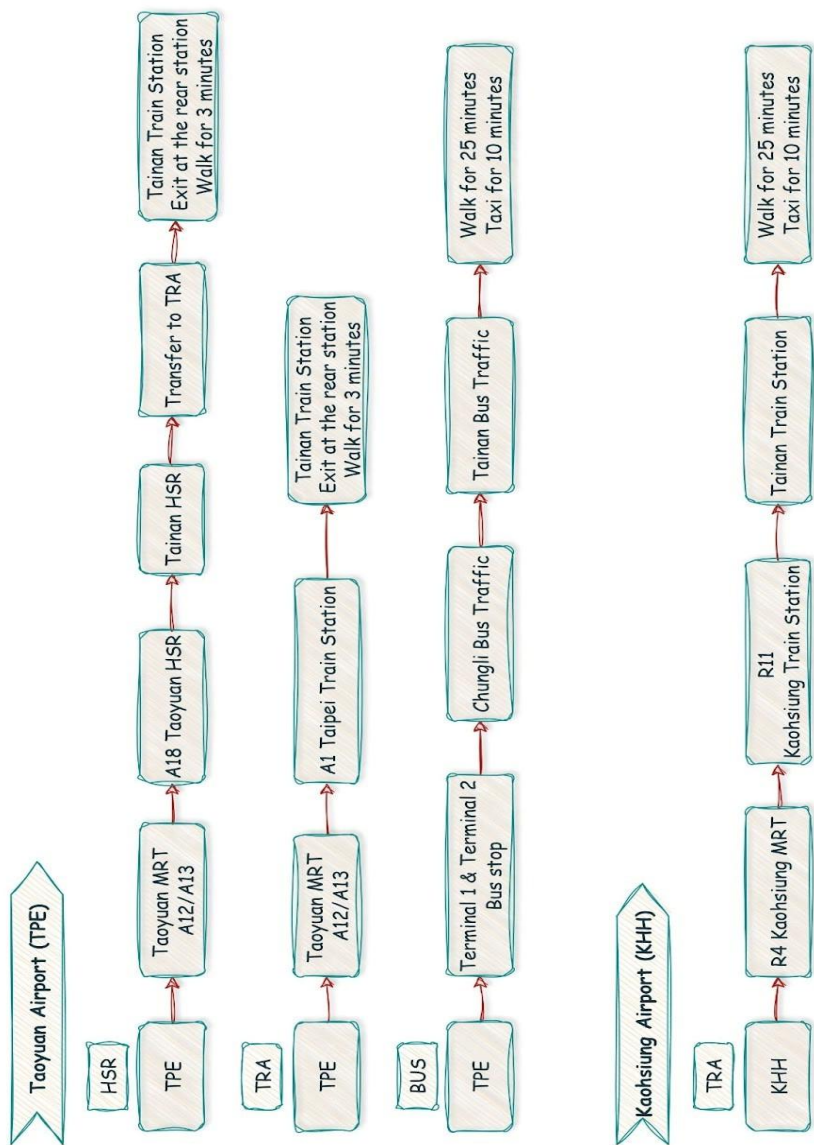
